

Brush Up On: Dental Emergencies



Abscess—is an infection that occurs around the root of the tooth and spreads into the spaces between the teeth and gums. An abscess can cause serious damage to the tissue surrounding the teeth and can potentially spread to other areas of the body. An abscess appears as a pimple like swelling (usually painful) on the child's gum tissue with possible swelling of the face and neck, and may be accompanied by a low-grade fever. The plan of action should be to contact your dentist right away

Dislocation of a Permanent Tooth: the tooth is partially or completely dislodged from the socket. Get to a dentist immediately! The faster you get there, the more likely it is that the tooth can be saved. Rinse the tooth with water but do not scrub it or remove any tissue fragments. If possible, re-implant the tooth in the socket, but never force it into the socket. If this is not possible, place the tooth in a cup of milk, saliva, or water. Handle the tooth by the crown only. Do not wiggle or pull a partially dislodged tooth out of the socket. Over the counter pain relievers such as Tylenol or Advil can be taken as needed.

Tips and Tricks for Halloween



To help you sort through the trick-or-treat bag loot, we have a rundown of some common candies and their impact on your teeth:

Chocolate

Chocolate is probably your best bet, which is good because it is also one of the most popular kinds of candy handed out on Halloween. It washes off your teeth easier than other types of candy. Dark chocolate also has less sugar than milk chocolate.

Sticky and Gummy Candies

Be picky if it's sticky. Sticky candies are the most challenging for our teeth. This candy is harder to remove and may stay longer on your teeth, which gives that cavity-causing bacteria more time to work.

Hard Candy

Hard candies are also ones to watch on Halloween. They can actually crack your teeth if you are not careful. You tend to keep these types of candies in your mouth for longer periods allowing the sugar to get in your saliva and wash over your teeth.

Sour Candy

You might want to pass on things that make you pucker – especially if they are sticky and coated in sugar. Sour candy can be very acidic. That acidity can weaken and damage the hard outer shell of our teeth, making them more vulnerable to cavities.

Popcorn Balls

Have some floss handy if you are enjoying one of these fall favorites because kernels tend to get stuck in-between your teeth. They are also sticky, sugary and can be hard.
